Previous researchers studied the environmental benefits of urban green spaces but primarily investigates the physical and emotional motivation of park areas and problems about uncounted on visitation. In this study investigate the issue of visitors facing when their visitation. Researcher used responses to a general population survey of urban residents in Diyatha Uyana urban park. Throw the observation researcher identified nine effective problems when visitation visitors were facing. There are (1) Effect of environmental noise (2) Effect of most population (3) Others disturbance to engage who doing exercise (4) Barriers to take 3D photos (5) Exist resources are enough (6) Organization's rules and regulation are difficult (7) Space of park is enough (8) Signing board are enough (9) Safety is enough. Researcher used one way Anova analysis to identify the most effective problem. Results from our sample suggest that visitation frequency to physical and emotional motivate factors, to relax is the most physical motive factor and Freedom is the most emotional factor. Based on the findings the researcher made a conclusion that the most visitors' effective problem was environmental noises. That problems significant level is 0.012, point of view, it should help planners, Park designers and city councils in Sri Lanka, as well as the general public, to understand and expand their knowledge of environment noise in urban park.
