

Personal pronouns of Hindi and Sinhala languages

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Sinhala and Hindi are two languages that have originated from Sanskrit which belong to Indo-Aryan languages. Pronouns are a common category of these two languages. The pronoun does a great task in keeping the coordination in the language itself. Simultaneously it is very significant in keeping the boredom away. Pronouns used in a particular language can be used to identify the composition of that society.
