

Relevance of Kabir's revealing poeties of caste system to modern Indian society

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Kabirdas, the greatest poet in the Nirguna Bhakthi, of the medieval era of Hind Literature showed strong protest against division of social strata based on the caste system in the Indian society.

The people belonging to low cast had been deprived of human rights and entirely depend on prestigious social clan. Kabirdas criticizes disparities of the Indian society where privileged social class entertains social prestige despite all human beings have been created by the same root of blood.

The study was primarily concerned with the analysis of the relevance of Kabir's poetry revealing caste system to present Indian society. A number of related classical Indian texts, magazines and other literary materials were reviewed for critical analysis of his poems. The major findings suggest the significant contributory role of Kabir in revolutionizing the modern Indian thought. The study also reveals the relevance of Kabir's sociological ideologies, humanism and literary devices to contemporary Indian society.

On the whole, it can be concluded that Kabir's sociological beliefs and philosophical thoughts have had drastic impact on shaping modern Indian value system towards a harmonies society free of caste discrimination.
