## A BRIEF STUDY ON THE MILINDAPANHA: IN THE VIEW OF HISTORY OF AYURVEDA.

he Milindapañha is the work, which records the questions asked by the king Milinda and the answers given by the Venerable Nāgasena. Some traditions like Burmese have given more importance to the Milindapañha, which has been treated as a canonical text. They treat it as a book of the Khuddakanikāya, the fifth division of the Suttapitaka. Even in India, some scholars consider the Milindapañha as a book of the Khuddakanikāya. The Milindapañha, according to the Sri Lankan tradition, is not included in the Khuddakanikāya and has been treated as an important non-canonical work.

The content of the *Milindapañha* is a conversation on religious and philosophical problems and disputed points of Buddhism. It is to be noted that though the *Milindapañha* is not important from the medical point of view some portions in the *Milindapañha* throw some light on the history of Ayurveda. It may be a determining factor of the date of the *Milindapañha*.
